Activities for Dot Cards

- **Find All the Ways to Make a Number**
Have the students sort through the cards to determine how many ways a designated number can be represented. Have the students compare the different representations. Ask them to see if they can find a different way.
- **Ordering**
Have the students take the cards and order them by quantity.
- **Classify**
Have the students sort the cards and then describe how they sorted them. Use a Venn Diagram and have them record their findings. Have them trade with another student to determine how they were sorted.
- **More or Less**
Two players. Divide the cards into two piles. Turn them face down. Each player turns over a card at the same time. The first person to say which card is the greater of the two wins the cards.
- **Sum War**
Two players. Divided cards into two piles. Turn them face down. Each player turns over a card at the same time. The first person to say the sum of the two cards wins the cards.
- **Difference War**
Two players. Divide the cards into two piles. Turn them face down. Each player turns over a card at the same time. The first person to say the difference of the two cards wins the cards.
