

Grade Level: $1^{\text {st }}-2^{\text {nd }}$
Objective: The student will (TSW) jump while counting the coins in a vertical line.
Outcome: Some students are kinesthetic learners and need to move to better understand concepts. Other students may benefit from learning the concept of counting money in a different way than a paper and pencil task.

Materials: *Large width masking tape (or whatever masking tape is available)
*At least 3 different vertical lines with a variety of coins, to be counted, spaced about every 2 feet
*Bags of plastic coins, felt for coin organization
Directions: *Teacher creates at least 3 different vertical masking tape lines on the floor with coins on them. (See example below.)
*Have each student in the group jump and count the coins while jumping.
*After jumping the lines, have the students work in pairs to collect all the coins included in a line.
*Have the students line the coins up in "jumping" order, then have them practice counting the change while "jumping" their fingers. *Have each pair of students practice jumping again and create a new set of coins for jumping.
